Since its inception in 2009, Urban BoatWorks has expected youth to build incredible boats, and in doing so develop the perseverance they need to succeed. Urban BoatWorks has expanded from its origins as a six-week summer module in 2009 into a year round program where different groups of students are in the shop every day during the school year, and paddling their fleet of over twenty boats on the rivers of Camden in the summers. Our students, from grades 6-12, come from private and charter schools in Camden, New Jersey. Currently, BoatWorks serves 130 middle and high school aged students through the program who are building, repairing, or restoring boats in a total of 14 cohorts this year.
