Over the years we have offered continuous summer and afterschool programs for approximately 150 high school and middle school boys and girls. We
 have now expanded to a 2000 sq.ft. shop and have built nine boats including a kayak and our pride and joy St. Ayles Skiff.

Our participants are experiencing various boat building skills including lofting, oar and paddle making, and scale model making.This past summer we developed ecology and rowing. An adult program will be offered in the winter.
