UANY Harbor School is a public 9 – 12 grade New York City high school with 6 New York State certified marine technology and science based career and technical education program.

UANY Harbor School serves 476 New York City 9th – 12th graders. The school accepted its 1st incoming class in the Fall of 2003 as one of four new small high schools opened in Bushwick High School. In 2010 the school moved to our current location on Governors Island off the southern end of Manhattan known as the battery. We are a public high school with a lottery admissions policy. After a core foundation class in 9th grade, Introduction to New York Harbor, students rank their preference of the six CTE programs – Aquaculture, Marine Systems Technology, Ocean Engineering, Marine Biology Research, Professional Diving and Vessel Operations. All students are required to attend a CTE program. We have a large variety of related extra-curricular activities related to these fields of study – Harbor Seals, Robotics, Rowing, Keel Boat Sailing, Dinghy Sailing, Boatbuilding, Welding, Waterfront Club, Fishing, Marine Engineering.
