Chesapeake Bay Field Labs (CBFL)

For these programs we use the skipjack, *Dee of Saint Mary's*, as a floating classroom. Our school programs are 4-hours long and involve both a shore side and a skipjack sail experience, and include a 30-minute lunch break. They are designed to immerse the students in an unforgettable field-based experience aboard a part of our local history.



Throughout the program, students are divided up into smaller groups and rotated through learning stations. The students spend 1.5 hours working on the dock and using the resources at the museum, and 2 hours aboard the skipjack. Two classes can participate in the program simultaneously, alternating shore side and sail, with up to 28 students and 2 adult chaperones/teachers participating in each group.
