Working with some of the most economically disadvantaged public schools in Boston, CBB reinforces core academic skills, builds confidence, and re-engages students in their educations. Our 5th grade students build 10-foot wooden flatiron skiffs using traditional craftsmanship. Students start the process excited



about the boats, have a revelatory experience when they realize how the skills they are learning in the classroom are essential to the project, and leave the program both determined to learn more and with the confidence to do so.
