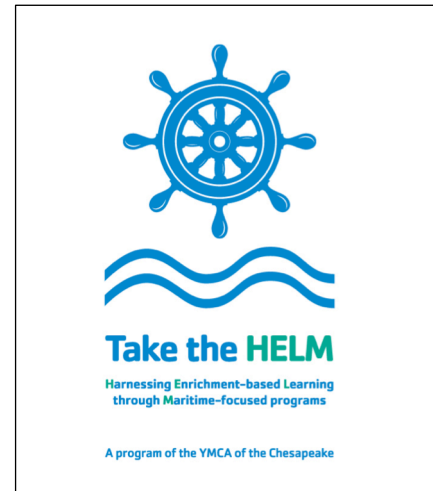


# YMCA of the Chesapeake
