New York Harbor School Rowing

This is an afterschool fixed-seat rowing program that uses traditional wooden boats, dubbed "Whitehall gigs," on the Hudson River in New York Harbor. High school teachers and volunteers coach a team that typically numbers 35-40 students per year. Practice is twice a week from September through November, and from April through June. Race crews self-select and compete against rival high schools in the annual VCB Youth Race, held in early November, and in other traditional-boat regattas in New England. There are also off-season boatbuilding and boat repair programs.
